CHAMP1516

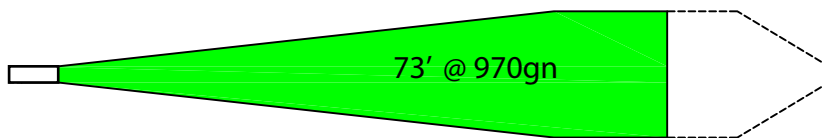
CHAMP1516 is designed to allow some custom cuts for 15' rod competitions either in water or on a deck. The total length of head is about 85' weighted 1170gn. The following charts are cuts that are designed for specific competitions, for example, Spey-O-Rama, World Championship - 15' catergory, JCA Internation Casting Competitions - 16' catergory. Please note: these cuts are a basic cut parameter for the competitions listed above.

There are, of course, more creative cuts are not covered in this instruction and waiting for you to find out.

Spey-O-Rama:

instruction:

1. cut 1.5' - 2' off at the front
2. measure 73' and cut off the rest

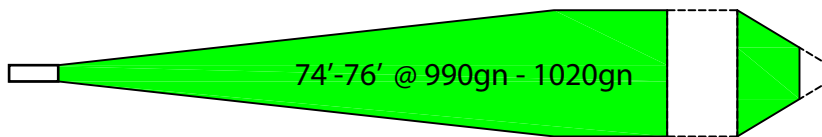


NOTE: 1.5' cut at front end would stabilize the forward loop. 2' cut at front will increase the shooting speed (very aggressive). you can also use some of backtaper to stablize the flight and easy on the rod tip if you get your head closer to the rod tip. Overhang: 3' -4' is recommended.

World Championship 15' catergory:

instruction:

1. cut 1.5' - 2' off at the front and measure 68 feet
2. use 6'-8' of backtaper



JCA International Casting Competition 16 catergory:

instruction:

Total length is 85' @ 1170gn.
The belly area is abut 22gn/foot.
Cut as many as from the belly area possible to suit your rod.
